LIGHT SHOW JUDGING COMPETITION

Suggested

CLASSES, RULES & SCORING

Classes:

- Class 1. Cruiser or non-Goldwing only non-moving lights.
- Class 2. Goldwing only non-moving lights
- Class 3. Bike or Trike with trailer or Bike with sidecar and Trailer, non-moving lights
- Class 4. Any combination of classes 1, 2 or 3 with computerized or moving lights.
- Class 5. "Optional" = Open pro or vendor class. Anything goes.

Rules:

- A. All participants must have full registration for the Rally or Event and be signed up for the Light Show Competition
- B. Lights, mounting and wiring cannot in any way jeopardize the safe operation of the unit or its occupants.
- C. The number of lights on a unit or units will not determine the winner. Judging will be based on the **Continuity**, overall **Pattern**, general **Appearance**, **Creativity** and the **Safety** of the display, not to include the Rider or Co-Rider.
- D. In case of a tie score, the Judges will converse and a winner will be selected.

Scoring:

Continuity	= 1 – 10 Points
Pattern	= 1 – 10 Points
Appearance	= 1 – 10 Points
Creativity	= 1 – 10 Points
Safety	= 1 – 10 Points

Notes: 1 point will be deducted for each non-operating light or bulb.
The Winners will be announced and given their awards (if applicable) at the conclusion of the light show or judging.

Each District has the option on how they wish to class and operate their light show competition.
