

Camping at the Region D Rally/Convention In Coldwater, MI

The Branch County 4H Fairgrounds in Coldwater, MI is a registered campground. There are no horses or livestock that are permanently housed within the Fairgrounds. Most of the roadways are either paved or seal coated. There are families of wild Canadian geese!

The facility has 144 full hook up sites for RV's with 30 amp electrical service, water & sewer. Most of the RV sites are set up so you cannot pull through, if you have a trailer, you may need to drop it, so check the site before entering. These sites are somewhat close to each other, so if you have a large unit with pull outs you may want to spread out a bit. We have plenty of room and most RV sites are satellite friendly.

They have 56 additional sites with electric and water including some around buildings & fences.

There are numerous primitive campsites available for those wanting them.

For those that wish to come in a set up early you are welcome to do that. Please go to the Fair Office to pay for your camping prior to Thursday September 16, 2010 @ \$15.00 per night.

The main restrooms & showers 3 men & 3 women are located north of Fairgrounds Ave in the northeast portion of the fairgrounds just east of the Rabbit & Poultry Barn. The other rest rooms & showers 1 man's & 1 woman's are located on the northwest portion of the fairgrounds just west of the Merchants Building.

There are restrooms only just east of the food court between Sanford Hall and the Home Economics Building. There are restrooms in the 4H Cabin and the Dearth Center as well.

The Fairgrounds does not allow on ground campfires they must be above ground.

Ice in bags will be for sale behind the Fairgrounds Office building at the garage. See Signs

The only entrance and exit that will be open from Thursday morning until Sunday morning will be at the Dearth Center entrance which is located on Garfield Ave on the south side of the Fairgrounds.

Some of the Region D Team and First responders will be camping on site and will have access to keys to open gates in case of an emergency.
